From Elementary Scholarships to University Dreams: The Lasting Impact of AFFLIP Sponsorships Since 2013, the Australian Foundation for Fostering Learning in the Philippines (AFFLIP) has been making a profound difference in the lives of young students in Davao City. Through our scholarship program, 806 children have received financial support to stay in school, covering essential expenses like tuition, books, uniforms, and extracurricular activities.

But what happens after elementary school? Does a small scholarship in Grades 4 to 6 really make a long-term difference?

The answer is a resounding yes—and we have the inspiring stories to prove it.

Alumni Spotlight: From Scholarship Recipients to University Students

At AFFLIP, we are thrilled to introduce some of our incredible alumni who once received an AFFLIP scholarship and are now pursuing higher education—a milestone that once seemed out of reach for many of them.

Take **Mel Joy A Lumalno**, for example. As a young student, financial hardship meant school was never a certainty. But with an AFFLIP scholarship, they had the support they needed to continue their education. Today, they are enrolled in the University of the Philippines, studying a Bachelor of Sports Science, and working toward a brighter future.

"AFFLIP didn't just help me stay in school—it gave me hope," says **Mel Joy A Lumalno**. "Without this support, I wouldn't be where I am today."

And **Mel Joy A Lumalno** is not alone. Thanks to the generosity of our sponsors, nearly all of our scholars have successfully transitioned from elementary to high school, and many are now taking their first steps in **university studies**.

Growing Healthy Minds and Bodies: Health and Nutrition Highlights

Over the past year, AFFLIP's Health and Nutrition Portfolio, led by Board members Pat Maloney and Ali Douglas, have worked with leaders and teachers across Talomo District schools to significantly strengthened student wellbeing. With health and nutrition at the heart of learning, the program has supported everything from first aid kits and dental care to food production and environmental sustainability.

Eight mushroom propagation sheds are now thriving in school grounds, with more planned through new funding applications. Hydroponics and aquaponics systems have been expanded—some producing income that supports school feeding programs and infrastructure. Aquaculture ponds, container gardens, and seedling nurseries now feature in many schools, often maintained by engaged parents and community volunteers.

AFFLIP's "Teeth and Gums" project provided dental care to 270 scholars, covering all costs and treating urgent needs. Meanwhile, schools have embraced sustainable practices, choosing flood-resistant garden sites and adapting to reduced land availability due to building works.

With strong support from the Departments of Agriculture and Fisheries, schools now grow more food, label plants with nutritional information, and use gardens as dynamic learning spaces. The Health and Nutrition TWG has taken on greater leadership, driving transparency, innovation, and partnerships.

Thanks to these efforts, AFFLIP is not only supporting schools to feed students but also cultivating healthy habits, skills, and futures.
